- (joint) publications on empirical questions relating to the effects of an unconditional basic income (labor market incentives, fiscal impact).
- in this context, the implementation of a PhD project is possible and explicitly desired.
- support in project administration and science management.
- collaboration in the corresponding FRIBIS UBILI team.
- co-supervision of final theses.
