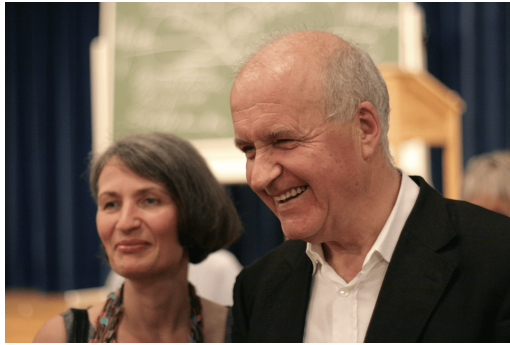
Basic Income Globetrotter: Prof. Jurgen De Wispelaere now in Freiburg

His academic interest in Basic Income has already taken Jurgen De Wispelaere to many places: from Belgium to Great Britain, Ireland, Australia, Canada, Spain, Finland, Argentina and finally Chile. His research focuses on Basic Income experiments and how they have affected policy-making. Prof. De Wispelaere will stay in Freiburg for three months to research, teach, write and share ideas with members of both FRIBIS and GWP.

In the summer term of 2023, Jurgen De Wispelaere will be hosting various academic events. Among them is [a seminar for Master's students](#) at the University of Freiburg and a Public Lecture Series, for which he has invited UBI experts to discuss with them key articles of their research.
